

Camping Rules & Guidelines

★ CAMPSITES

- ★ Payment due immediately at arrival and choosing a site.
- ★ If you are staying without a horse(s), please pick a site without corrals if possible!
- ★ If a reserved sign is posted, please move to another spot!
- ★ Pick a site that is appropriate for your size of rig & number of horses. 1 horse per paddock, 2 horses per camp, additional horses \$5 per night. Additional vehicles/tent \$5 per night.
- ★ Do Not move or disassemble panels or pens.
- ★ Park straight into your chosen site. Please do not park lengthwise & block adjacent sites. If you overflow into other sites, payment is required for both sites.
- ★ Please cleanup your corral after use, as rates do not include that service, leave as you would like to find it. No manure, water container upside down & hay removed. Bring your own manure fork & water containers to keep sharing germs to a minimum.

★ CAMPFIRES

- ★ Campfires must be kept within the fire rings provided.
- ★ Firewood is available for purchase in town, please respect the natural setting of the camp area, do not cut down trees! Campers must abide by State or local burn bans.

★ GENERAL

- ★ Water is limited in this area, only use the amount you need. No hookups available at this time!
- ★ Quiet time is 10 pm - 8 am! Be courteous to your campsite neighbors. Limit noise & lights.
- ★ No Motorcycles/ATV/UTVs allowed on upper level, unless approved by owners or a service vehicle.
- ★ Ride with the safety of yourself and others in mind. Do not ride through the courtyard or other campsites. Respect privacy of all.
- ★ Pets must be controlled at all times, preferably leashed.
- ★ Pack-In, Pack-Out! Leave No Trace!
